iPad Apps. Be prepared for most teachers to designate iPad Apps for students to acquire throughout the course of the year. Most of these apps will be free. Some teachers have listed specific iPad Apps in their supply lists, and students are expected to have those on their iPads.

Look on the chart and find your teacher's name, then the subject.

Helpful Hint: Find a way to make textbooks and notebooks stand out from each other in your locker. Use different colors of notebooks or labels on the spines. You will be grabbing your supplies quickly between classes, and you want a way to make sure you get the right book or notebook.

Please note that teachers may make minor changes and/or additions to the supply list when school begins. This list is provided as a courtesy to help you be as prepared as possible for the first day of school.
